### The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012

#### Notice Issued under Regulation 5 (Procedures Prior to Private Meetings), regarding the procedures prior to private meetings

Regulation 5 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 requires that a notice be published at least five clear days before any Cabinet meeting, where confidential or exempt information is to be considered in private (with the press and public excluded from the meeting).

This is in addition to the 28 clear days' notice given by the Cabinet Forward Plan, which was updated on 19 September 2017, giving details that the document(s) listed below are due to be considered in private. The Forward Plan was made available on 19 September 2017 through the Council's website and on the Barrel Vault public noticeboard at Ripley Town Hall.

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Regulation 5 that the Cabinet intends to consider the following documents in private:
