Thereafter creating an alternative footpath from Point A (Grid Reference SK42905 54163 proceeding in a east northeast direction to Point C (Grid Reference SK42922 54171) for a distance of 19 metres or thereabouts. Continuing from Point C (Grid Reference SK42922 54171) approximately east south east turning north west turning east south east turning generally north to Point D (Grid Reference SK42955 54187) for a distance of 100 metres or thereabouts. Thereafter from Point D (Grid Reference SK42958 54186 proceeding in a eastward direction to Point E (Grid Reference SK43012 54186) for a distance of 53 metres or thereabouts. Then continuing from Point E (Grid Reference SK43012 54186 proceeding in a northerly direction to Point F (Grid Reference SK43010 54194) for a distance of 9 metres or thereabouts. Thereafter from Point F (Grid Reference SK43009 54195) proceeding in north northwest direction to Point B (Grid Reference SK 43001 54214) for a distance of 21 metres or thereabouts as shown on the order map.
