

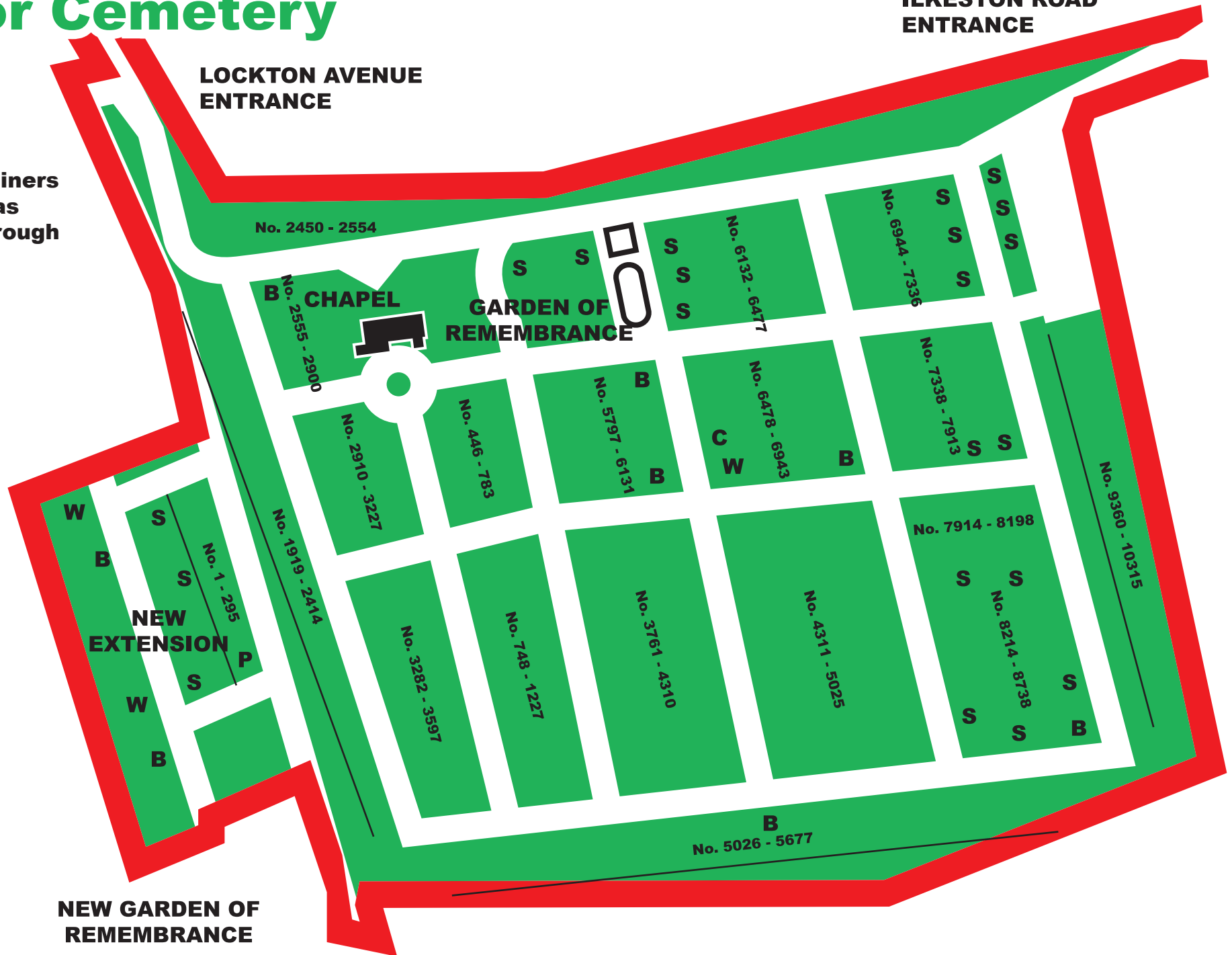
Location	Ilkeston Road, Marlpool, Heanor, Derbyshire DE75 7BP
Site	Attractive cemetery with an avenue of lime trees planted in Victorian times. Pleasant small chapel available for services.
History	Opened as a cemetery in 1858.
Opening hours	Weekdays: Gates open from 8.00am until sunset with vehicle access. Weekends: Pedestrian access only.
Parking	Weekdays: Parking available in front of the Chapel and main drive Weekends: Pedestrian access only.  Extension Area vehicle access for funerals and maintenance only.
Chapel	Available for services, seating approx 45 with access for wheelchair users.
Facilities	Water, water containers, seating (see map overleaf).
Cemetery records	Viewing available at the cemetery, contact the Cemetery Office to arrange (see below for contact details).
Burials	<b>Sections:</b> <b>Main.</b> <b>Extension.</b> <b>Infants.</b> <b>Garden of remembrance.</b>  New single 5 foot and double 7 foot plots, re-open graves and burial/ scattering of cremated remains are available.
Memorials	All headstones, memorials and inscriptions are subject to approval from the Cemetery Office. Memorial approval forms are available from the Council or through a Council approved Memorial Mason.
