Outcome:

The petition was submitted to Full Council on 28 September 2011.

It was resolved as follows:

“That consideration of the petitions be deferred until the next Full Council meeting so that they can be considered alongside the officers’ reports that are expected for that meeting.”

At the meeting of Full Council held on 2 November 2011, it was:

“RESOLVED UNANIMOUSLY

- 1 That the Chief Executive is authorised to continue with the negotiations for the grant of a lease to Ripley Town Council, on the principle terms outlined in the report, with the exception of the capital sum offered for the Town Hall, and such detailed terms as he considers appropriate, and to report back to Council when the negotiations are completed, so that it can be satisfied pursuant to the requirements of the legal implications contained in the report, and be content that such a grant will not prejudice the disposal or re-use of the Central Headquarters’ building as part of the strategic review of the Council’s operations; and
- 2 That the Chief Executive, in consultation with the Chairman of the Planning Board, be authorised to respond to English Heritage in respect of the application to ‘List’ the Town Hall.”
