Site	Small pleasant cemetery. Easily accessible, with attractive trees and shrubs.
History	Opened as a cemetery in 1858.
Opening hours	Weekdays: Gates open from 8.00am until sunset with vehicle access. Weekends: Pedestrian access only.
Parking	Weekdays: Parking very limited. Weekends: Pedestrian access only.
Facilities	Toilets, water, water containers, seating (see map overleaf).
Cemetery records	Viewing available at the cemetery, contact the Cemetery Office to arrange (see contact details below).
Burials	Sections: Main - all sections within the main area of the cemetery are lawned. Extension. infants. Garden of remembrance. New single 5 foot and double 7 foot plots, re-open graves and burial/scattering of cremated remains are available.
Memorials	All headstones, memorials and inscriptions are subject to approval from the Cemetery Office. Memorial approval forms are available from the Council or through a Council approved Memorial Mason.
