History

Opened as a cemetery in 1895

Opening Hours

Weekdays - Gates open from 8am until sunset with vehicle access
Weekends - Pedestrian access only

Parking

Weekdays - Limited parking available at the back of the Chapel
Weekends - Pedestrian access only

Chapel

Available for services, seating approx 44 with access for wheelchair users

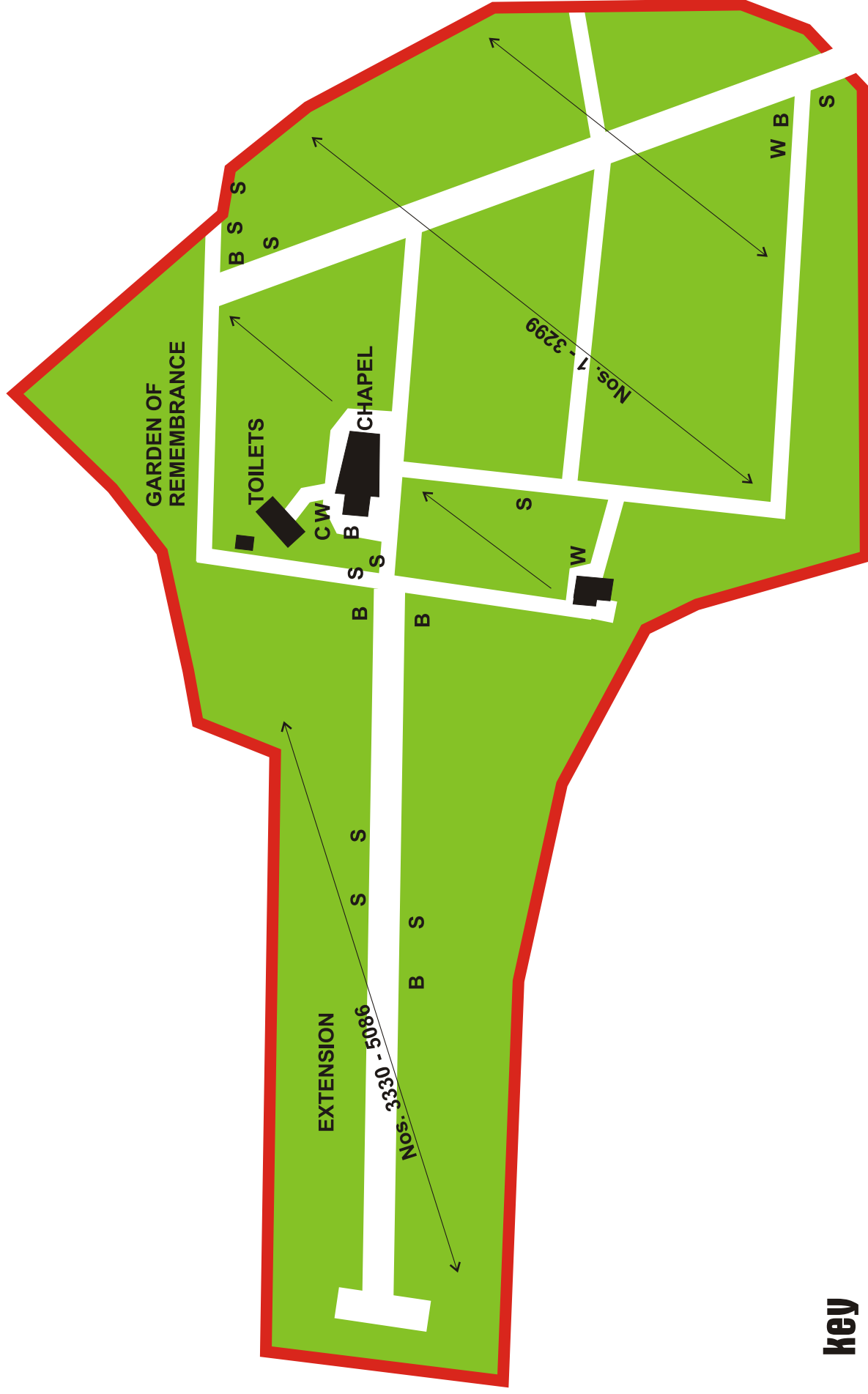
