

GAMBLING ACT 2005

NOTIFICATION OF 2 OR LESS MACHINES

GUIDANCE NOTES

1. Is there an automatic entitlement to Gaming Machines?

Section 282 of the Gambling Act 2005 (“the Act”) provides an automatic entitlement to make available two gaming machines (of category C or D – **see below for details**) for use in alcohol-licensed premises. To take advantage of this entitlement, the Premises Licence Holder must give notice to the Licensing Authority of their intention to making gaming machines available for use, and must pay the prescribed fee.

The notification is not transferrable. The notification does not expire nor does it have an annual fee.

2. What are the categories of machines available?

Category of machine	Maximum “Stake”	Maximum Prize
C	£1	£70
D	10p money prize	£5 money prize
	30p non-money prize	£8 non-money prize
