

Belper Cemetery

General Information

Location	Matlock Road, Broadholme, Belper, Derbyshire DE56 2JE
Site	Set on a steep incline with clay soil, overlooking the Derbyshire countryside.
History	Originally created as an arboricultural site, opening as a cemetery in 1859.
Opening hours	Weekdays/ Weekends: Gates open from 8.00am until sunset with vehicle access.
Parking	Parking available in front of the Chapel, some limited parking within the cemetery (see map).
Facilities	Toilets, water, water containers, seating (see map).
Cemetery records	Viewing available at the cemetery, contact the Cemetery Office to arrange (see below for contact details).
Burials	<p>Sections:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Main - all sections within the main area of the cemetery are lawned.Extension - all new sections within the main area of the cemetery are lawned.Woodland.Infants.Garden of remembrance. <p>New single and 'side by side' 5 foot plots, re-open graves and burial/ scattering of cremated remains are available.</p>
Memorials	All headstones, memorials and inscriptions are subject to approval from the Cemetery Office. Memorial approval forms are available from the Council or through a Council approved Memorial Mason.
