The site supports neglected stands of rough grassland and tall herb that still includes some species of interest. Rushes, meadowsweet, cow parsley and hogweed occur with tufted hair grass, cock's-foot, false oat grass and Yorkshire fog. The herbaceous associates include climbers such as meadow vetchling and large bird's-foot-trefoil with some more robust species like common knapweed also present.

The site is largely unmanaged and increasingly dominated by more robust grasses and taller herbs. In addition there is some scrub invading the edges of the site.

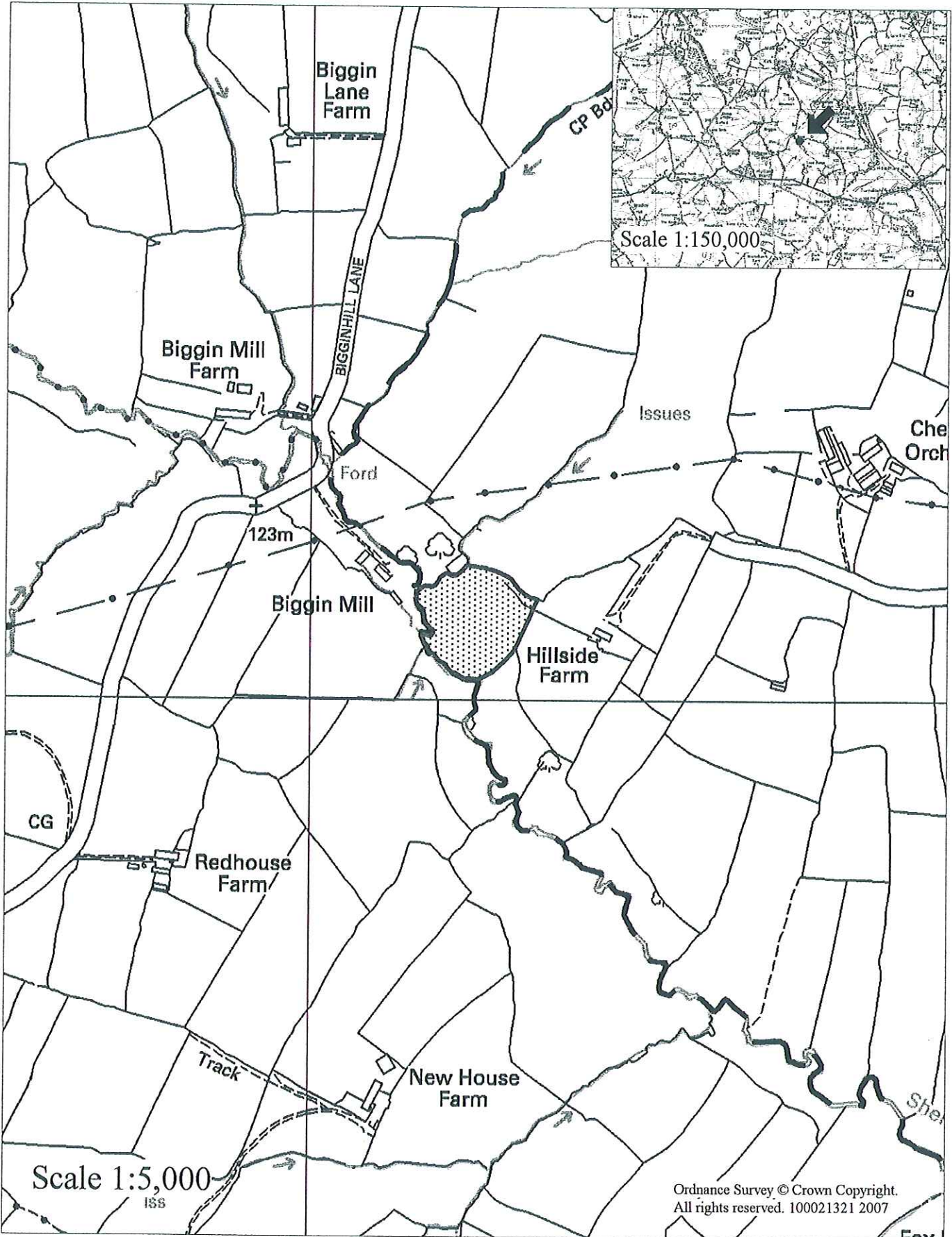
