Number of Signatures: Over 10,000

Outcome: As the petition contained in excess of 1, 200 signatures, it was debated at Full Council on 24 January 2018. At that meeting (Minute No 4246 refers), the Council considered a five minute presentation about the petition. The Council then advised that the petition would be passed to Derbyshire County Council, as landowners for the former American Adventure site. The petition was forwarded to Derbyshire County Council on 31 January 2018.
