The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012

Notice Issued under Regulation 10 (General exception), regarding the Intention to take Key Decisions without 28 clear-days notice

Regulation 9 of the above Regulations requires 28 clear days' notice to be given of all 'key decisions' taken on behalf of the Authority. Where that notice is impracticable, the decision can only be made where:

- the Chairman of the Improvement & Scrutiny Committee has been informed in writing – or, if there is no such person, each member of the relevant Overview and Scrutiny Committee by notice in writing, of the matter about which the decision is to be made;
- the Council has issued a Public Notice (i.e. this Notice), setting out the reasons why compliance with Regulation 9 is impracticable; and
- five clear days have elapsed following the issue of the Notice.

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Regulation 10 that the Leader of the Cabinet intends to make the following key decisions without the 28 clear-days' notice on the anticipated date of 20 May 2020:

Approval of final Future High Street Fund bid (Heanor High Street) and associated available allied capital funding	Leader, 20 May 2020	Public	The Future High Streets Fund bid deadline is 5 th June 2020 and a decision on the matter is required before that date. Further guidance on bid requirements has been released during the process, which includes co-funding requirements. Given that the bid documentation is still being finalised, it is not possible to defer the decision whilst achieving the submission deadline.

The Chairman of the Improvement & Scrutiny Committee was informed of the intention to take the key decision detailed above by email, dated 12 May 2020.
