- 3 Completed nomination papers must be delivered to the Returning Officer at the Main Reception, which is located under the bridge at the Town Hall, Market Place, Ripley, Derbyshire DE5 3BT on any day after the date of this notice, but no later than 4pm on Friday 6 April 2018. Office opening hours are Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday 9am – 4.30pm and on Wednesdays 10am – 4.30pm (excluding Bank Holidays).
- 4 If the election is contested the poll will take place on **THURSDAY 3 MAY 2018**.
- 5 Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by midnight on Tuesday 17 April 2018.

- 6 New Applications, amendments, re-direction or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Town Hall, Market Place, Ripley, Derbyshire DE5 3BT by 5pm on Wednesday 18 April 2018.
- 7 New Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Town Hall, Market Place, Ripley, Derbyshire DE5 3BT by 5pm on Wednesday 25 April 2018.
- 8 Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons, must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Town Hall, Market Place, Ripley, Derbyshire DE5 3BT by 5pm on 3 May 2018. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on 25 April 2018. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on 25 April 2018.
