THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES (EXECUTIVE ARRANGEMENTS) (MEETINGS AND ACCESS TO INFORMATION) (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2012

NOTICE ISSUED UNDER REGULATION 10 (GENERAL EXCEPTION), REGARDING THE INTENTION TO TAKE KEY DECISIONS WITHOUT 28 CLEAR-DAYS NOTICE

Regulation 9 of the above Regulations requires 28 clear days' notice to be given of all Key Decisions taken on behalf of the Council. Where that notice is impracticable, the decision can only be made where:

- the Chairman of the Improvement & Scrutiny Committee has been informed – or, if there is no such person, each member of the relevant Overview and Scrutiny Committee by notice in writing, of the matter about which the decision is to be made;
- the Council has issued a Public Notice (i.e. this Notice), setting out the reasons why compliance with Regulation 9 is impracticable; and
- five clear days have elapsed following the issue of the Notice.

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Regulation 10 that the Leader of the Council intends to make the following key decisions without the 28 clear-days' notice:
