The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012

Notice Issued under Regulation 5 (Procedures Prior to Private Meetings), regarding the procedures prior to private meetings

Regulation 5 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 requires that a notice be published at least five clear days before any Cabinet meeting, where confidential information is to be considered in private (with the press and public excluded from the meeting).

This is in addition to the 28 clear days' notice given by the Cabinet Forward Plan, which was updated on 1 December 2014, giving details that the report listed below is due to be considered in private. The Forward Plan was made available on 1 December 2014 through the Council's website and on request in Main Reception at Ripley Town Hall.
