### The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012

#### Notice Issued under Regulation 5 (Procedures Prior to Private Meetings), regarding the procedures prior to private meetings

Regulation 5 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 requires that a notice be published at least five clear days before any Cabinet meeting, where confidential information is to be considered in private (with the press and public excluded from the meeting).

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Regulation 5 that the Cabinet intends to consider the following document in private:

For commercial reasons the Council needs to consider this matter further as soon as practicable. There are no scheduled meetings of Cabinet prior to the meeting of Annual Council on 20 <sup>th</sup> May. There will be unnecessary delay and the scheme may be prejudiced if the matter is deferred.
