The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012

Notice Issued under Regulation 5 (Procedures Prior to Private Meetings), regarding the procedures prior to private meetings

Regulation 5 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 requires that a notice be published at least five clear days before any Cabinet meeting, where confidential information is to be considered in private (with the press and public excluded from the meeting).

This is in addition to the 28 clear days' notice given by the Cabinet Forward Plan, which was updated on 9 June 2015, giving details that the documents listed below are due to be considered in private. The Forward Plan was made available on 9 June 2015 through the Council's website and on the Barrel Vault public noticeboard at Ripley Town Hall.

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Regulation 5 that the Cabinet intends to consider the following documents in private:

Potential Possession Proceedings	Cabinet, 8 July 2015	Private	The report contains information (1) relating to an individual; (2) which is likely to reveal the identity of an individual; (3) in respect of which a claim to legal professional privilege could be maintained in legal proceedings and (4) which reveals that the authority proposes to either give, under any enactment, a notice under or by virtue of which requirements are imposed on a person; or to make an order or direction under any enactment as set out in Paragraphs 1, 2, 5 and 6 of Part 1, Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act 1972 respectively and the public interest in dealing with the matter in private outweighs the public interest in disclosing the information at a public meeting.
